Am I eligible?

To apply for iQTS you will need to have:

- ✓ A **bachelor's degree** from a UK or non-UK university or other institution
- ✓ A **maths qualification** equivalent to GCSE grade 4
- ✓ A **science qualification** equivalent to GCSE grade 4 for teaching children aged 3 to 11
- ✓ **Excellent written and verbal English language skills** with a minimum IELTS score of 6.5

You do not need any teaching experience or to be currently working in a school to apply for iQTS.

With iQTS, you'll be eligible to apply for English qualified teacher status (QTS) without any additional fees or training required. You'll then be qualified to teach in all English schools, as long as you have the right visa or immigration status.
